Thank you for you continued patience and support during the improvement works at Kewstoke Primary School.

Since our last update, the extension has now been erected and contractors are continuing to work hard to install electrical and mains supplies whilst also progressing finishings such as doors and kitchenettes. Everybody involved is excited to see the transformation of the school environment which will be fantastic for the children, staff and parent/carers.

On Friday 31 May, the one-way road management system outside of the school will be lifted. After this time, the contractors use of the road and school drop off system will be coordinated within the standard Highways Code for the area.

North Somerset Council is re-surfacing the Chapel Car park as part of the Kewstoke Primary School project. The Chapel are closing their car park from Friday 24 May to Sunday 2 June so that these works can take place. During this time, contractors finishing works at the school will park in other areas and we expect disruption to be kept to a minimum. We would like to thank St. Paul's Church for their patience whilst works are completed.

Thanks to all those who continue to support the improvement works along with the brilliant members of staff at Kewstoke School who work with the contractors daily, to ensure that the complex construction programme progresses alongside school life as smoothly as possible.
